Pediatric cancer can be isolating. Goodtimes' hallmark is creating shared experiences that give kids the ability to connect. While we were thrilled to be able to provide alternate options to in-person, kids-only camps since the onset of the pandemic, it was imperative to find safe ways to return to our roots in 2022. And oh, did we!

Together with our medical taskforce, we created viable plans designed to flex if needed but at their core allowed us to safely embrace being together again. All four of our camps—Camp Goodtimes, Kayak Adventure Camp, Mini Camp, and Sibling Ski Camp—ran in their traditional iterations and welcomed back a combined total of 143 campers ranging in age from 5–22.

True to form, the value of in-person, kids-only camps shone bright. Hope, love, and joy were abundant as campers connected face-to-face and embraced being in one another's presence. Old friendships were rekindled, new bonds were formed, and our sense of community was strengthened.

In person wasn't solely reserved for campers. Donors at the Goodtimes Gala, our largest annual fundraiser, excitedly jumped at the opportunity to gather together and give generously—leading to our highest single-event fundraising total ever!

As we look ahead, our focus remains on creating safe and loving spaces for kids to be kids. Help us continue to affirm the joys of childhood/young adulthood by supporting programming that brings kids together and encourages play and problem solving while building self-confidence and friendships to last a lifetime.

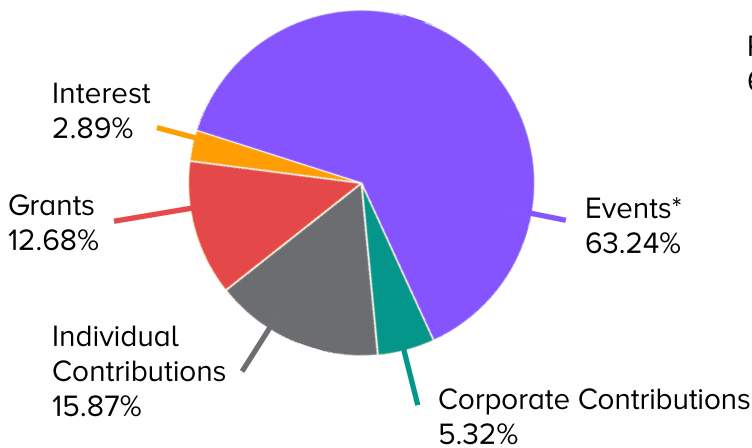

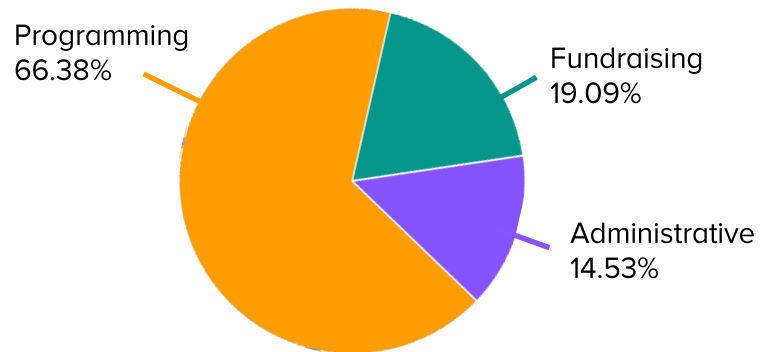
Revenue
