Check-in Process: Ski Camp

Check-in for Sibling Ski Camp is in the parking lot of Church for All Nations in Tacoma.

For directions use this address:

- Check-in time is 12:00 noon
- When you get to the parking lot, look for a large Bell Air charter bus
- There will be two “stations” all campers must complete
 - Paperwork
 - Med Shed and Health Screen

STEP 1: Paperwork Staff will first check that you have completed the required camper permission form. If you have not already submitted Notarized Permission Form online, this is when you must hand it in. We advise that you send in your paperwork before camp as this will help speed up the check-in process. *A notary will be on hand in case you need one.* At this time you will also need to fill-out and sign the White Pass rental equipment release form. This gives White Pass permission to rent skis and boots to your child.

STEP 2: Health Check Next, our Ski Camp nurse will ask whether your camper has medications (including vitamins, supplements, etc.) or special care instructions that need to be administered throughout the weekend. If your child has any medications, you will go over dosage and schedule, as well as answer any questions the nurse may have for you. Please bring enough medications for the entire weekend in their original containers. Please label all bags with the child’s name. If you do not have any medications, or once you have gone over this with the nurse, they will move onto the health screen, doing a quick check for signs of cough, cold, sore throat, etc.

After completing both steps, you can help your camper load their belongings into the bus storage. They are all checked in!
