You can express your commitment to The Goodtimes Project, through your estate planning, by making a bequest to benefit The Goodtimes Project. Bequests are revocable and can be easily created by including one of the following paragraphs, or similar language recommended by your estate planning attorney, within your Last Will and Testament.

You can place one of the following statements in your will to indicate your intention to support The Goodtimes Project:

### *Specific Bequest*

“I give to The Goodtimes Project of Seattle, Washington the sum of \$\_\_\_\_\_ (OR all my right, title and interest in the following described property) to be used in such manner as the Board of Directors of The Goodtimes Project shall, in its sole discretion, determine.”

### *Residuary Bequest*

“I give to The Goodtimes Project of Seattle, Washington the residue of my estate to be used in such manner as the Board of Directors of The Goodtimes Project shall, in its sole discretion, determine.”

### *Proportional Bequest*

“I give to The Goodtimes Project of Seattle, Washington (a stated percentage or a fraction of the residue of my estate) to be used in such manner as the Board of Directors of The Goodtimes Project shall, in its sole discretion, determine.”

### *Contingent Bequest*

“In the event that \_\_\_\_\_ (name of spouse, child, sibling, etc.) shall not survive me, then I give the same to The Goodtimes Project of Seattle, Washington to be used in such manner as the Board of Directors of The Goodtimes Project shall, in its sole discretion, determine.”
